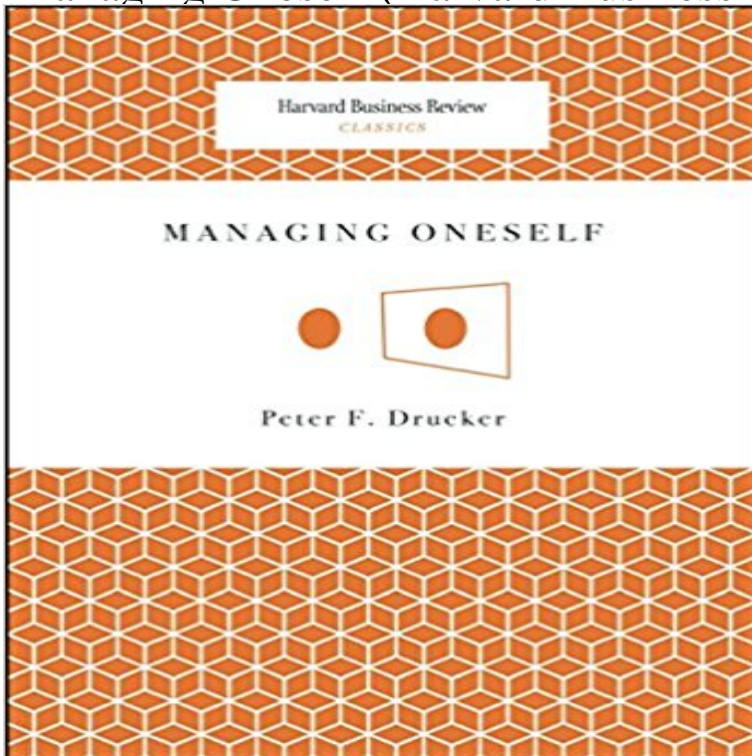


## Managing Oneself (Harvard Business Review Classics)
