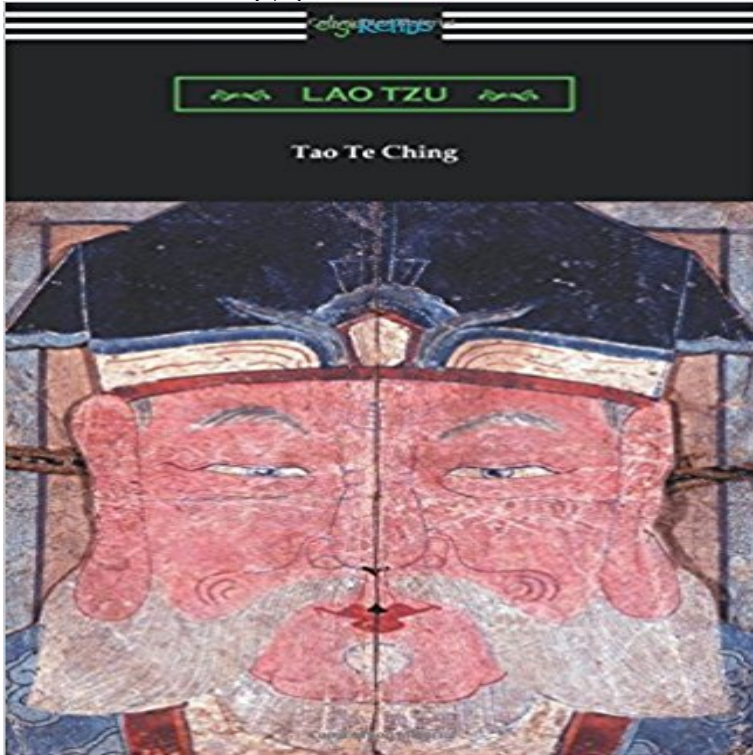


Tao Te Ching (Translated with commentary by James Legge)
