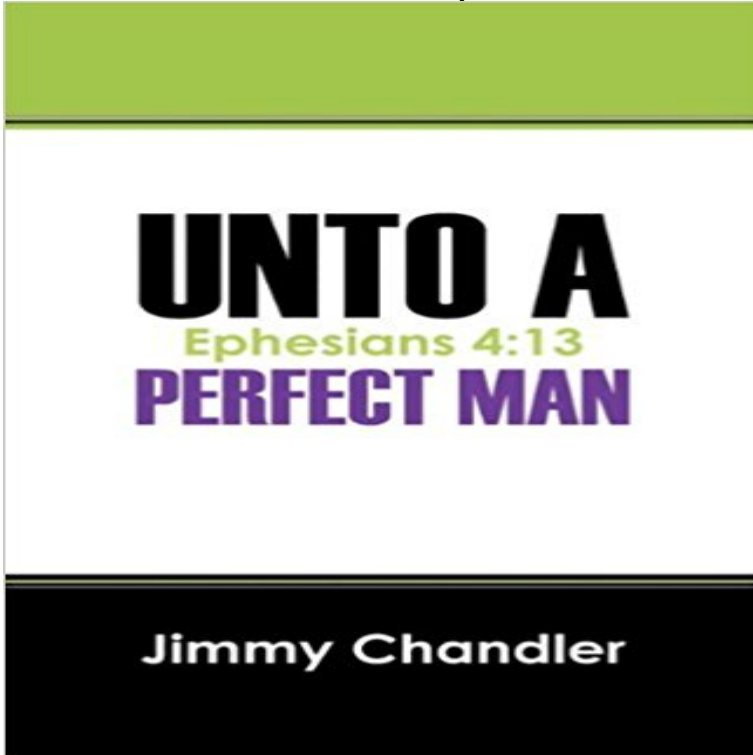


Unto A Perfect Man: Ephesians 4:13
