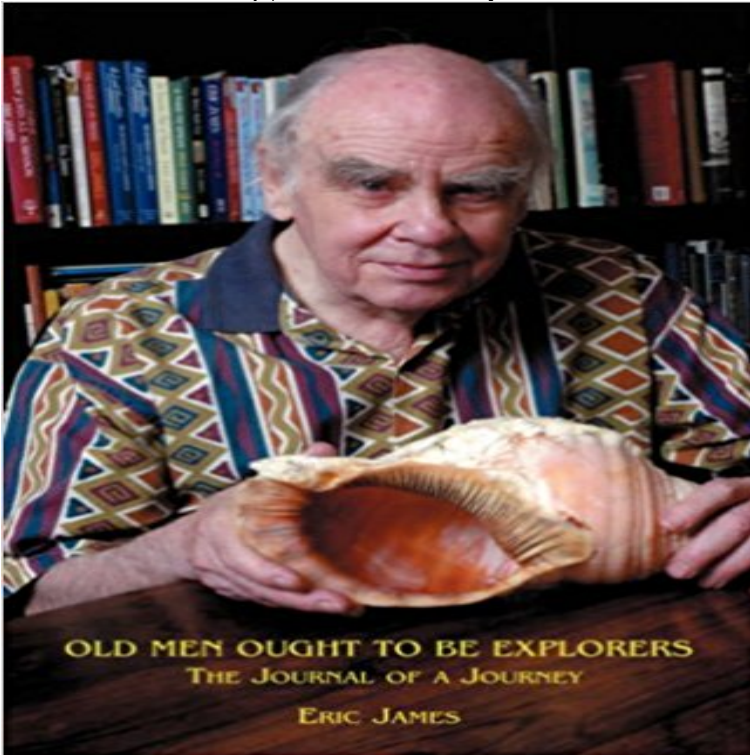


Old Men Ought to be Explorers



The Anglican clergyman, Canon Eric James was born in 1925. He was formerly Chaplain of Trinity College, Cambridge, Preacher to Grays Inn, Director of Christian Action and Chaplain to HM the Queen. He is well-known as a preacher, broadcaster, especially on Radio 4s Thought for the Day, and is the author of many best-selling books. He lives in retirement in London.
