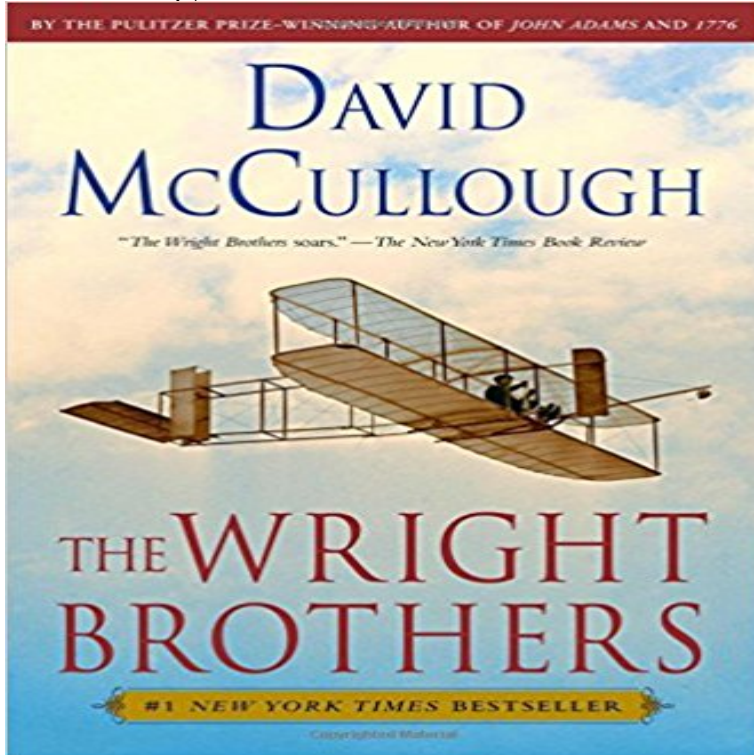


The Wright Brothers
