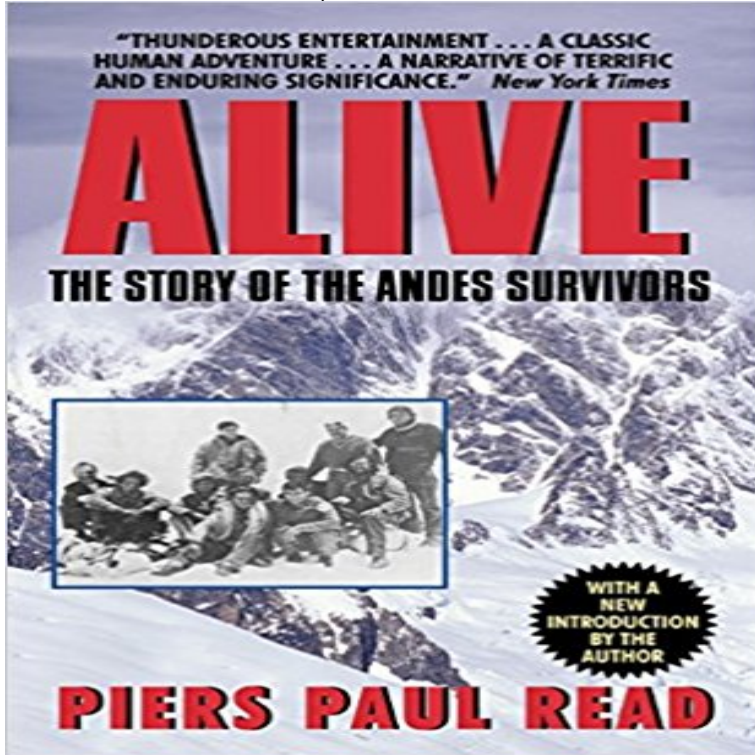


Alive: The Story of the Andes Survivors
