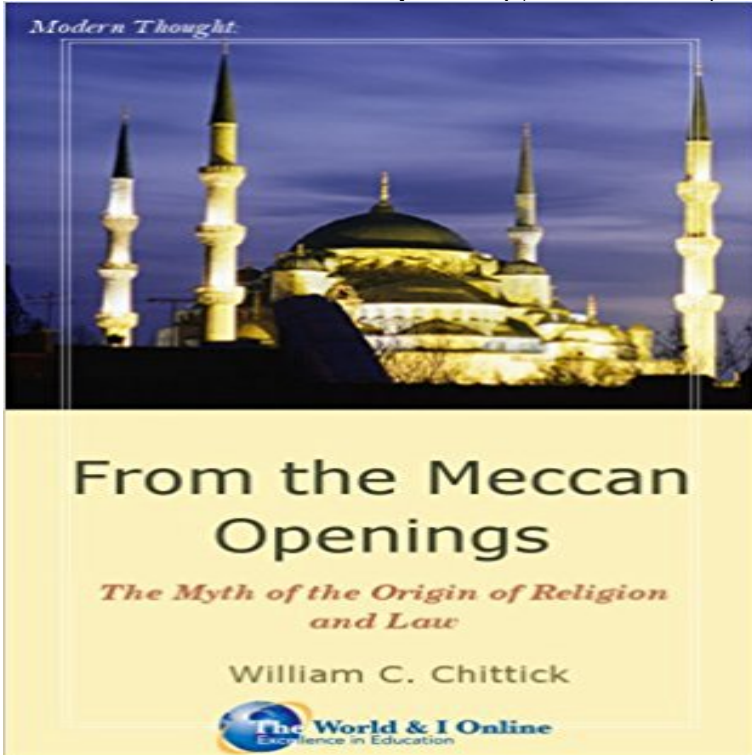


From the Meccan Openings: The Myth of the Origin of Religion and Law

He synthesized Islamic law, theology, philosophy, mysticism, cosmology, psychology, and other sciences in a manner that has for the past seven hundred years wielded tremendous influence over Islam. His Meccan Openings (al-Futuhât al-makkiyya), which will fill more than fifteen thousand pages in its new edition, provides a few glimmers and flashes of the luminous sciences he acquired when God opened for him the door to the Treasuries of Unseen Generosity. Ibn al-Arabi wrote several hundred other works, at least three hundred of which are extant.
