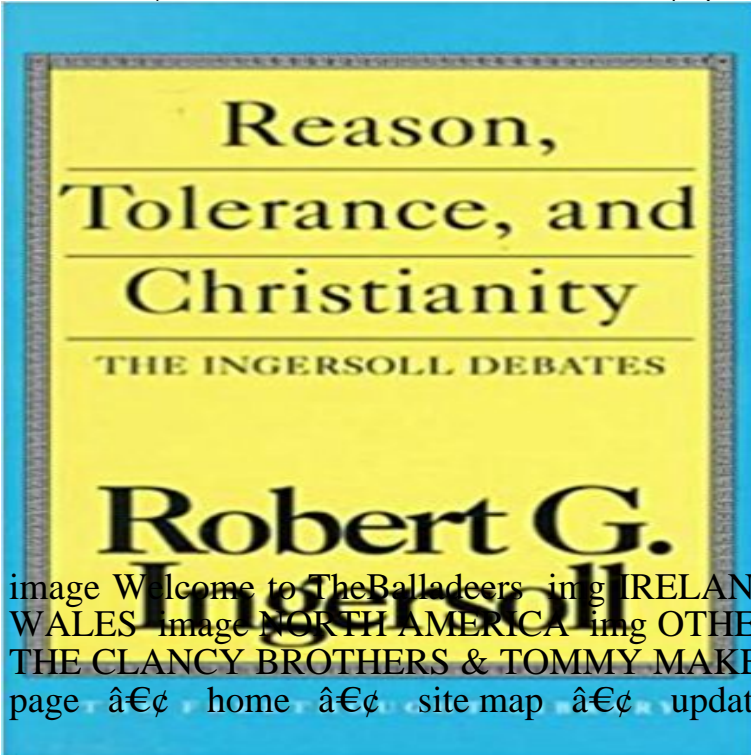


# Reason, Tolerance and Christianity (Freethought Library)
