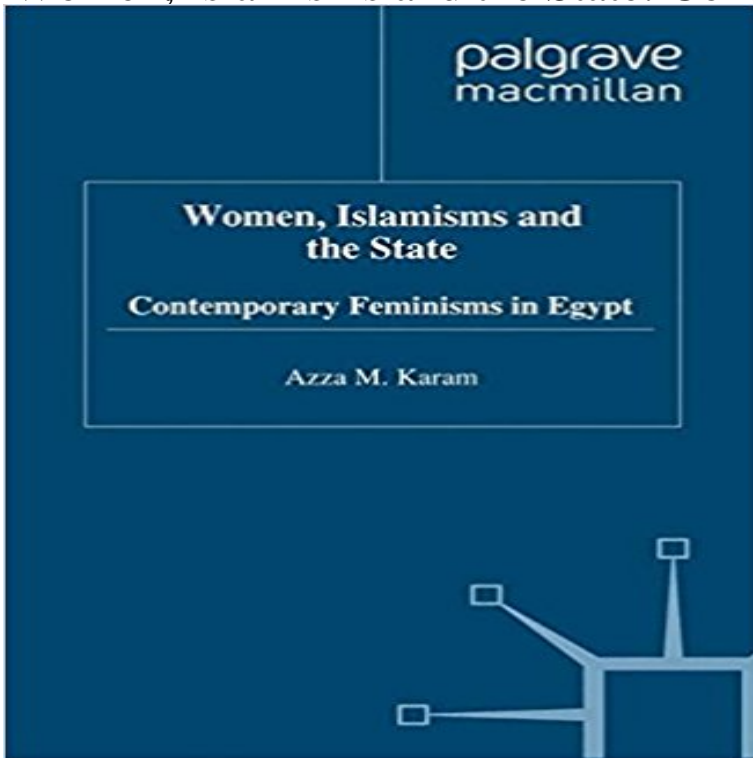


Women, Islamisms and the State: Contemporary Feminisms in Egypt
