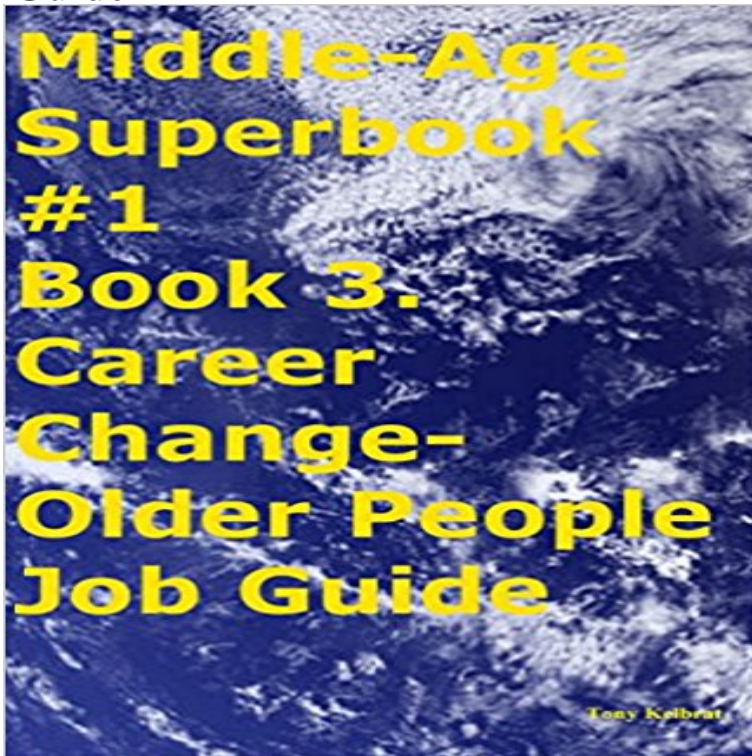


Middle-Age Superbook #1 Book 3. Career Change-Older People Job Guide
