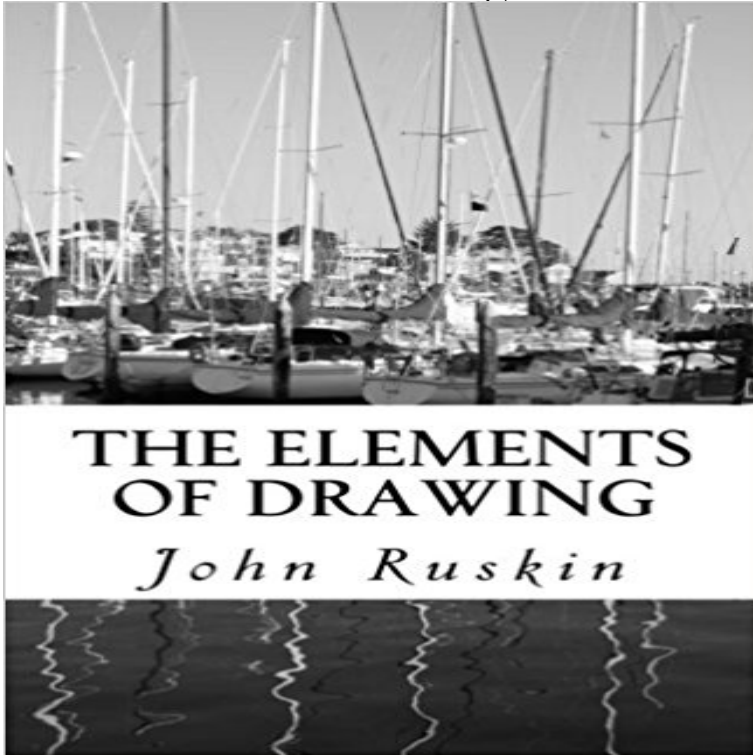


The Elements of Drawing
