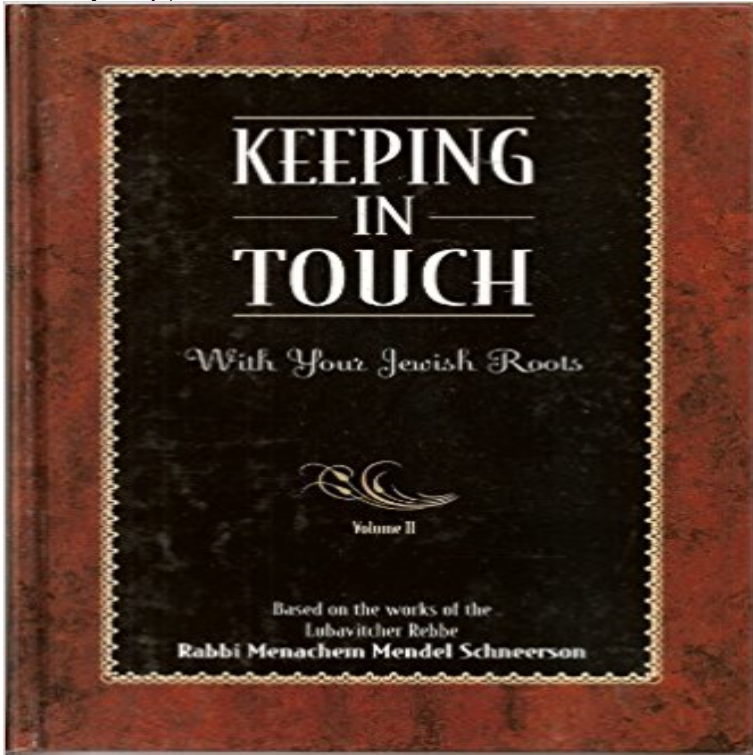


Keeping in Touch Vol. 2
