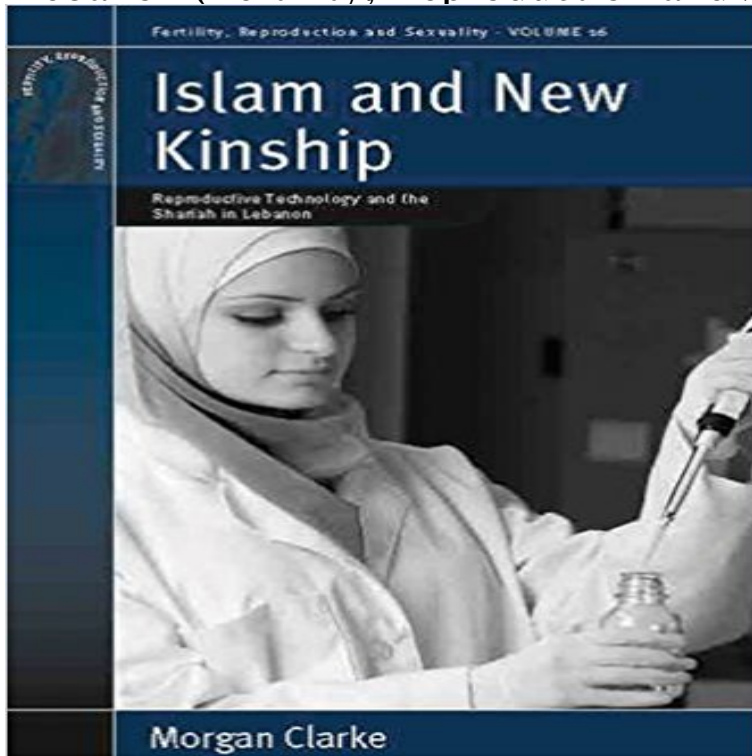


Islam and New Kinship: Reproductive Technology and the Shariah in Lebanon (Fertility, Reproduction and Sexuality)

As this book shows, Muslim perspectives focus on the moral propriety of such controversial procedures as the use of donor sperm and eggs as well as surrogacy arrangements, which are allowed by some authorities using surprising and innovative legal arguments. These arguments challenge common stereotypes of the rigidity and conservatism of Islamic law and compel us to question conventional contrasts between liberal and Islamic notions of moral freedom, as well as the epistemological assumptions of anthropology's own new kinship studies. This book will be essential reading for anyone interested in contemporary Islam and the impact of reproductive technology on the global social imaginary.
