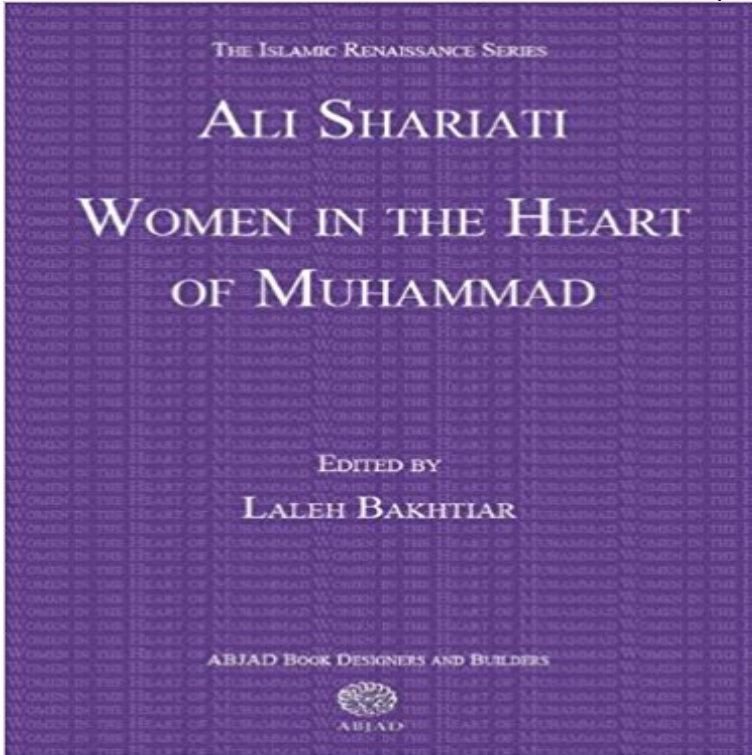


## Women in the Heart of Muhammad (Islamic Renaissance Series)

At the same time it obliges the male to provide for her to whatever extent she may demand even to the point of compensating her for nursing her own infant. She is entitled to a gift from her bridegroom, and although today this right is usually relinquished, in the past it represented the independent character of the woman and provided economic security against inauspicious future circumstances. She is also granted civil and religious equality with men, factors which make women powerful within society and independent of men who have always desired dictatorial domination over them.
