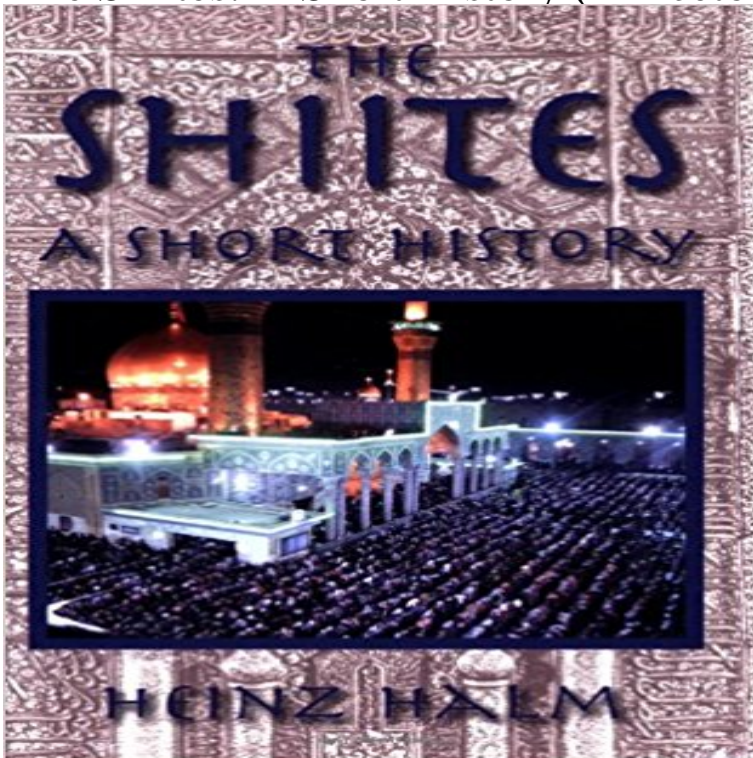


## The Shiites: A Short History (Princeton Series on the Middle East)



Combining history, comparative religion, and political interpretations, the author elucidates Shiism and political developments in the Middle East for the Western reader. The author highlights three main aspects of Shia Islam: its historical development, especially the history of the Imams, the rituals, including flagellation and passion plays, and the rules of the mullahs, known as the government of experts. Halm explains the exalted position of the religious scholars, the mullahs and ayatollahs, who established themselves as clergy in the Safavid Empire and defined themselves as the administrators of the Hidden Imam. The relationship between the rulers of Iran and the mullahs has always been tense. The Khomeini revolution was the powerful culmination of a lengthy historical conflict that has expanded into Iraq and Lebanon after the American invasion in Iraq.
