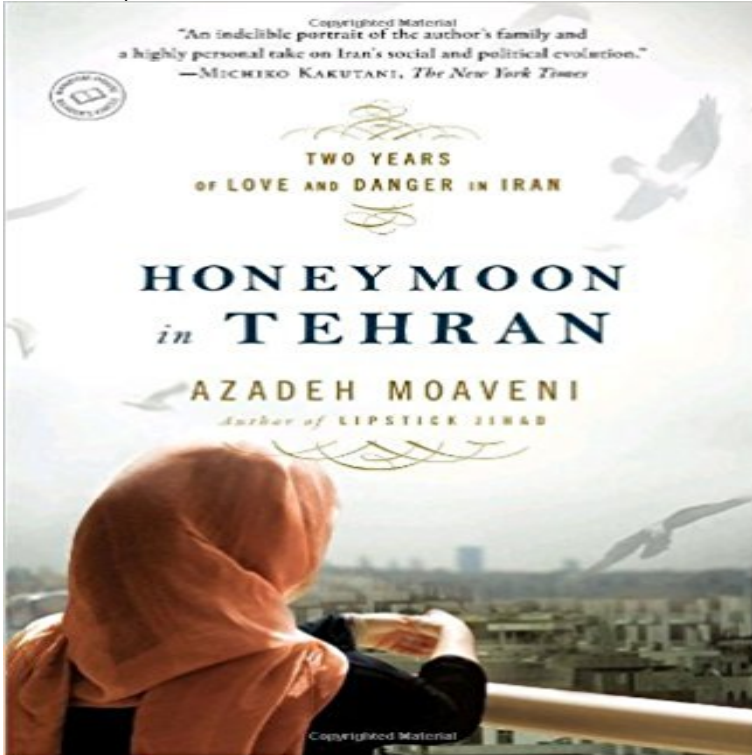


Honeymoon in Tehran: Two Years of Love and Danger in Iran
