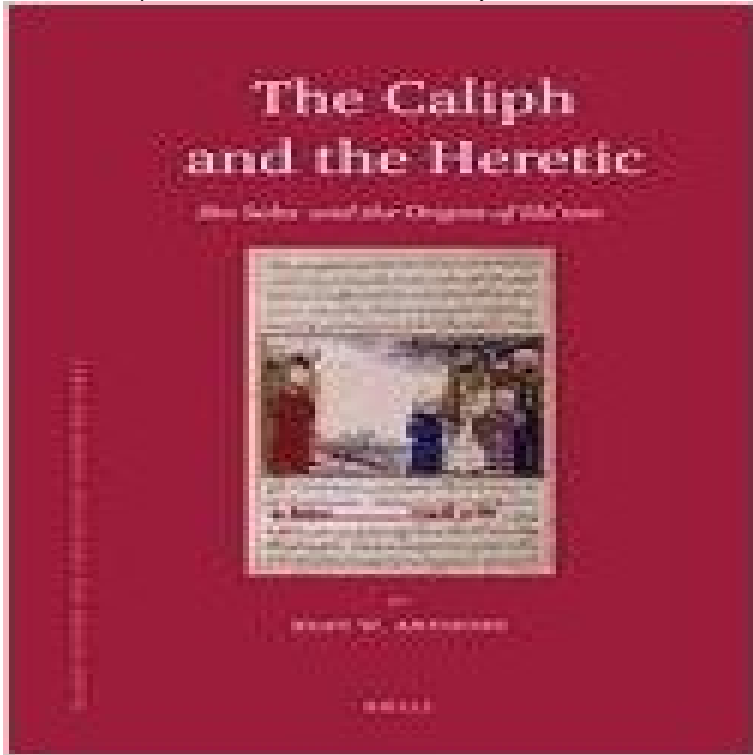


The Caliph and the Heretic: Ibn Saba and the Origins of Shiism (Islamic History and Civilization)
