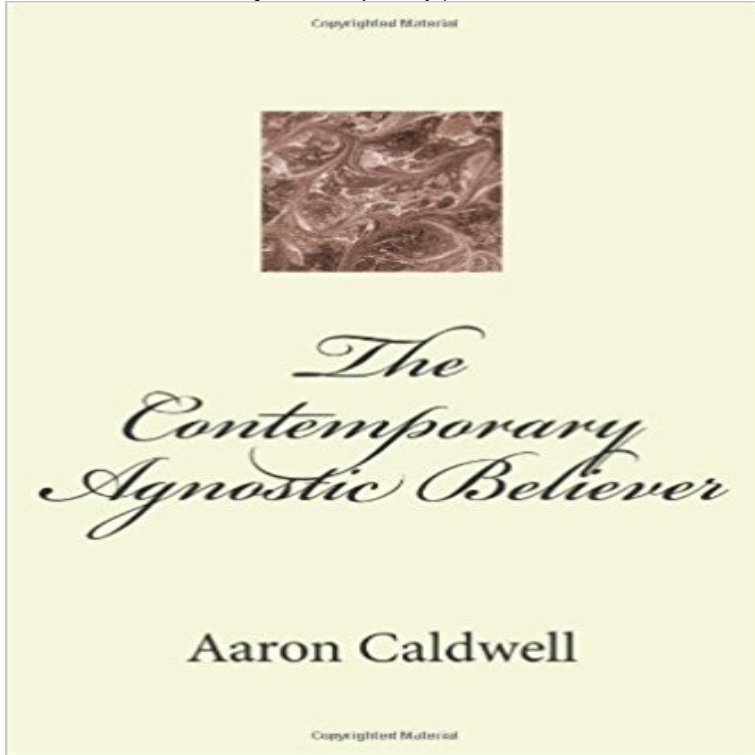


The Contemporary Agnostic Believer (Point of View)
