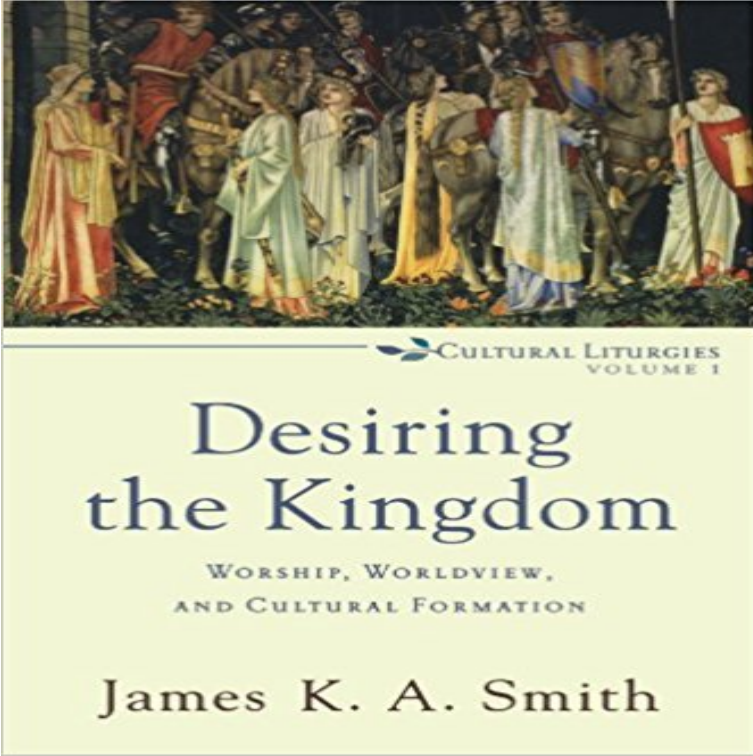


Desiring the Kingdom: Worship, Worldview, and Cultural Formation (Cultural Liturgies)
