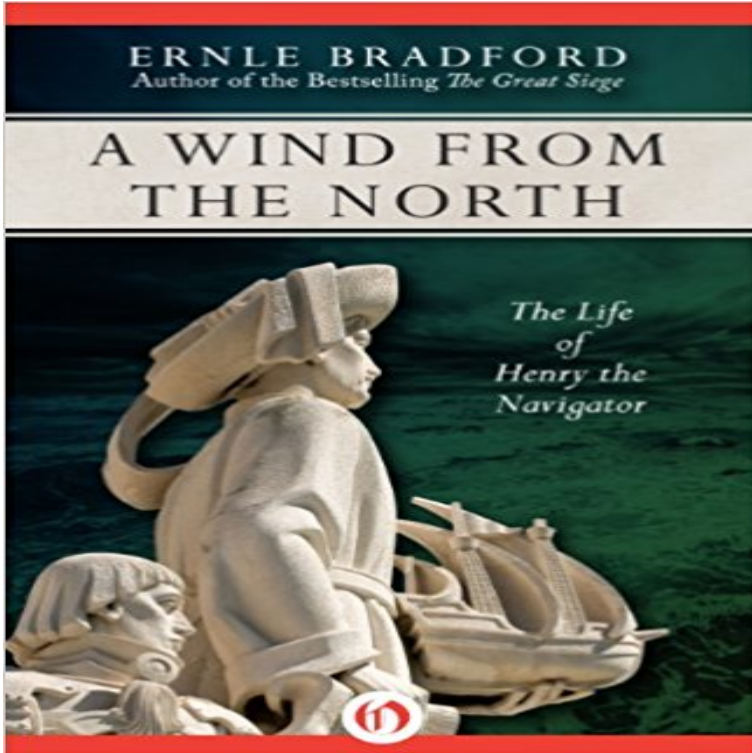


A Wind from the North: The Life of Henry the Navigator
