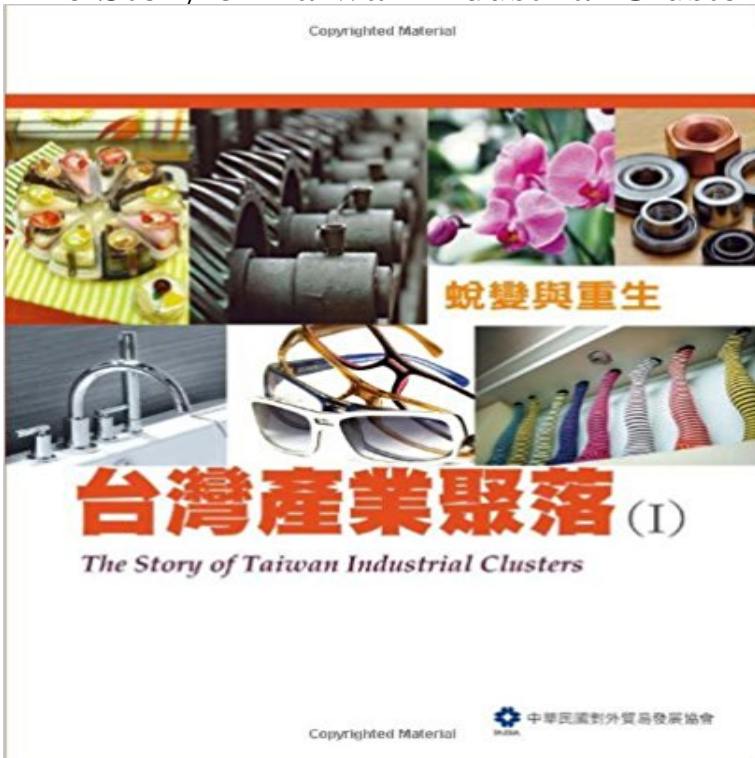

This book is divided into seven sections featuring important domestic industrial clusters: machine tools, plumbing hardware, hosiery, towels, orchids, eyeglasses and fasteners.
