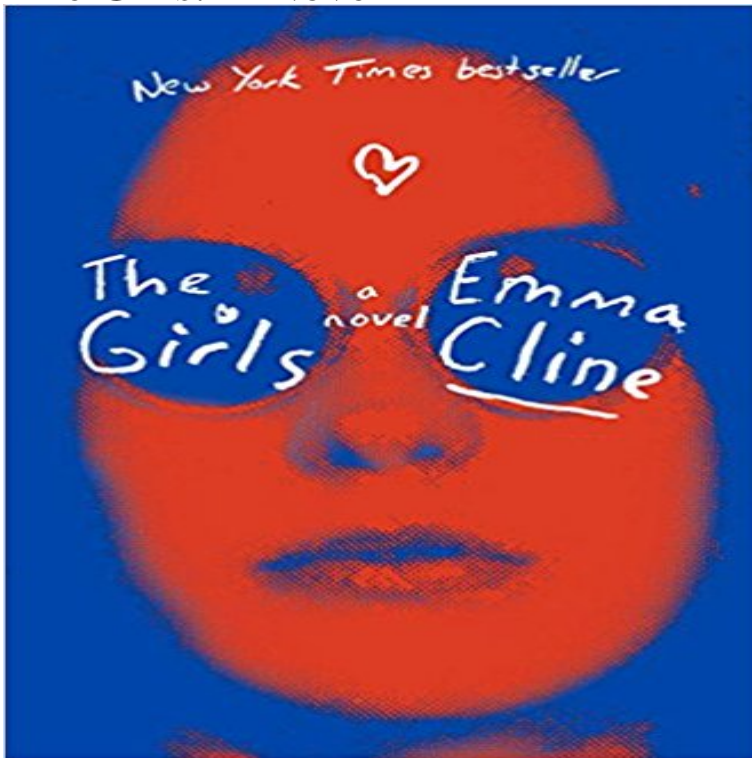


The Girls: A Novel
