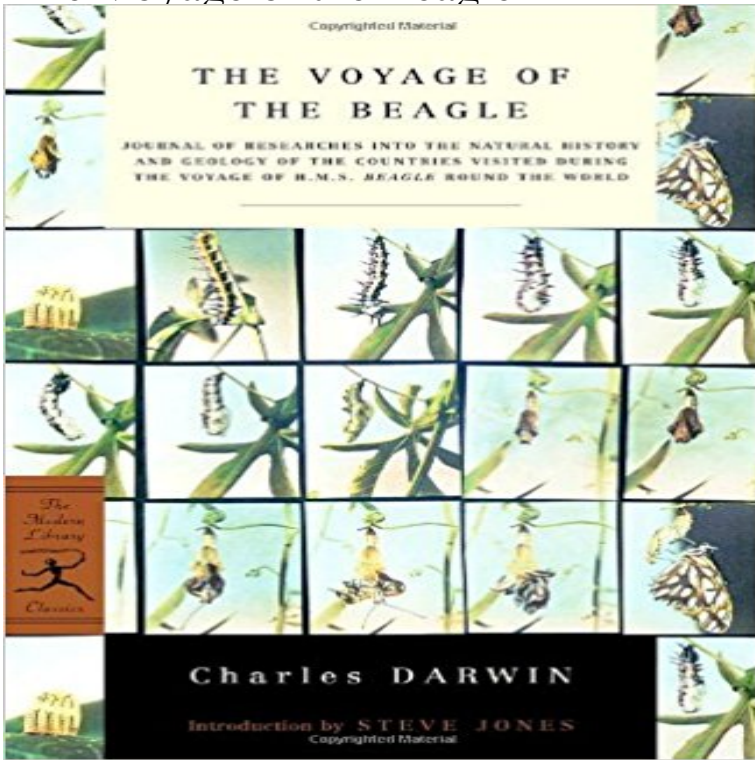


The Voyage of the Beagle
