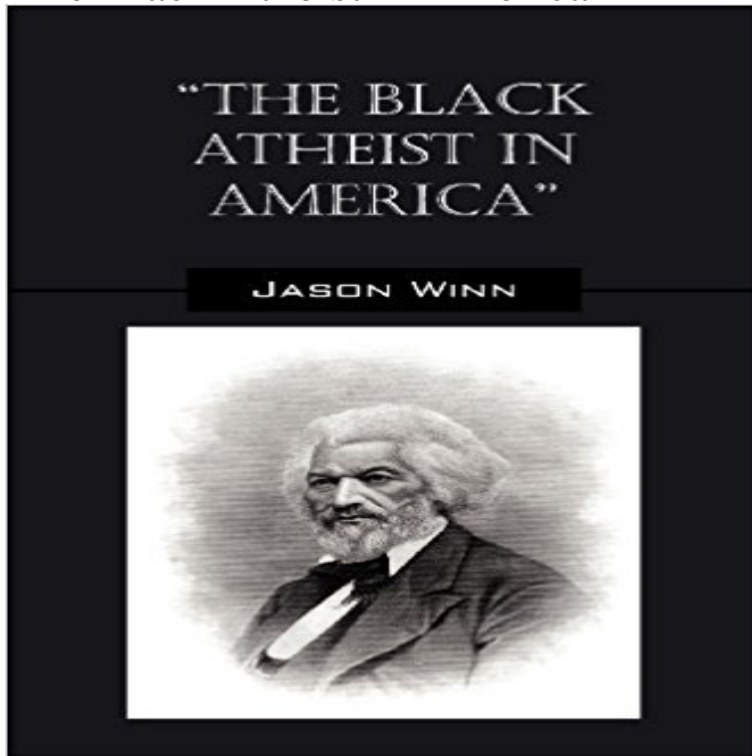


The Black Atheist in America
