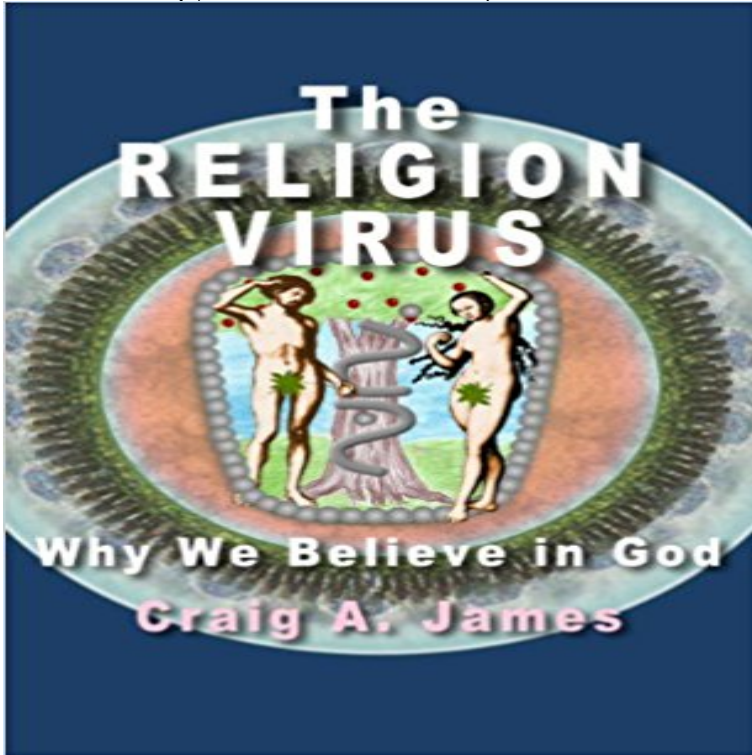


The Religion Virus: Why we believe in God
