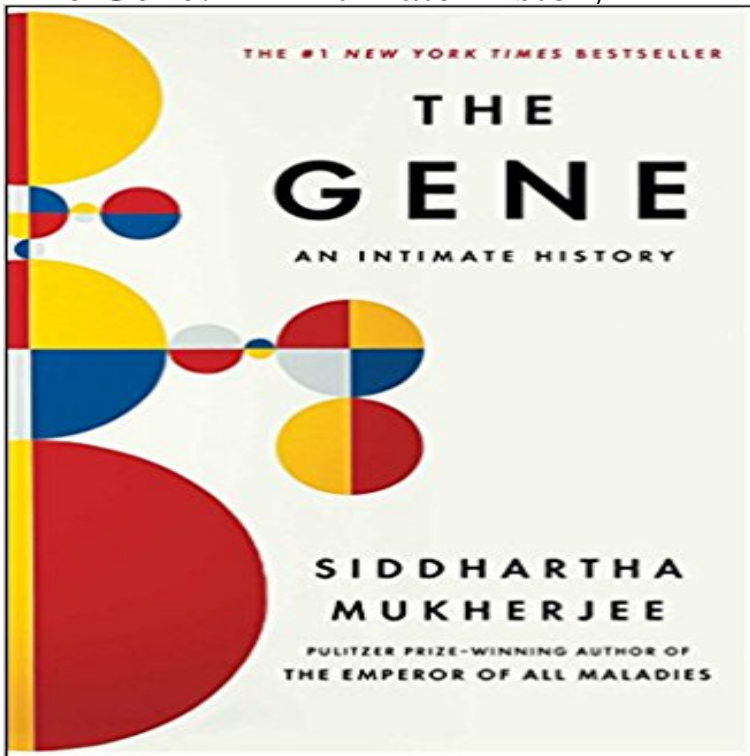


The Gene: An Intimate History
