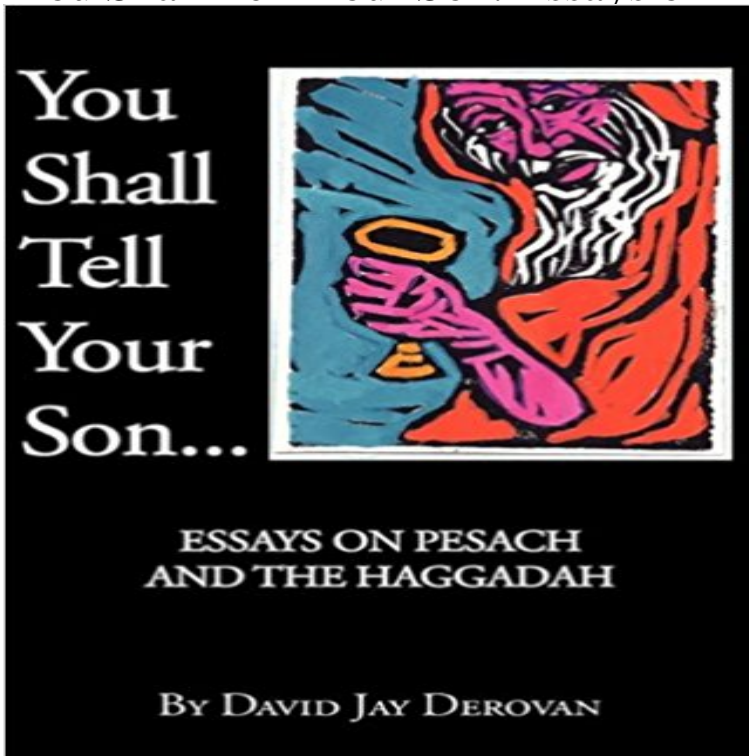


You Shall Tell Your Son: Essays on Pesach and the Haggadah
