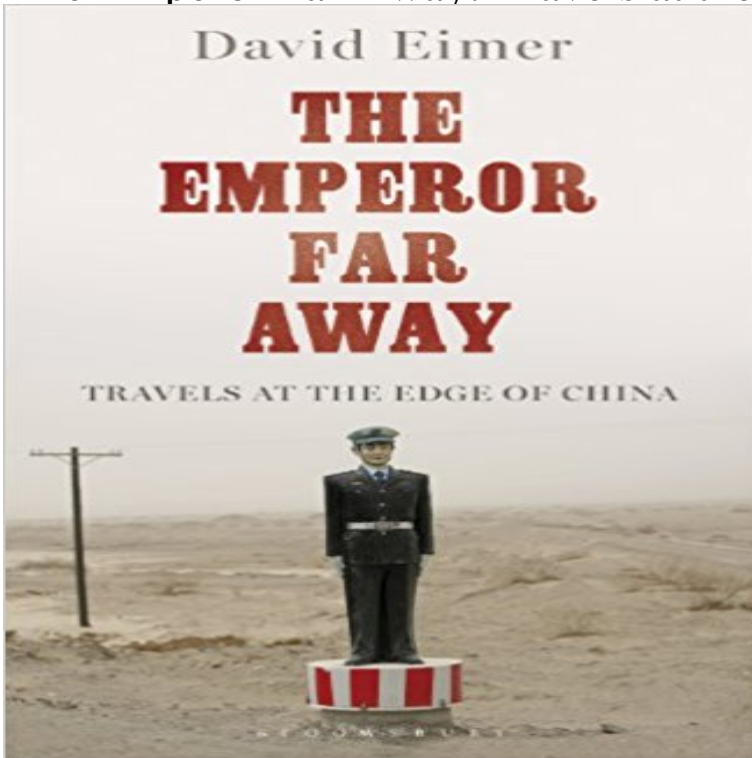


# The Emperor Far Away: Travels at the Edge of China
