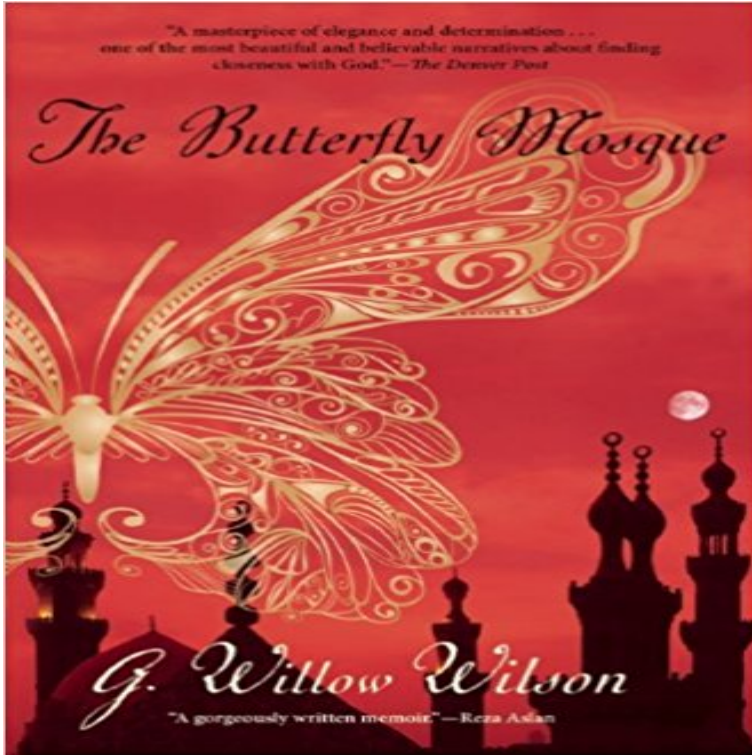


The Butterfly Mosque: A Young American Woman's Journey to Love and Islam



The Butterfly Mosque, journalist G.
