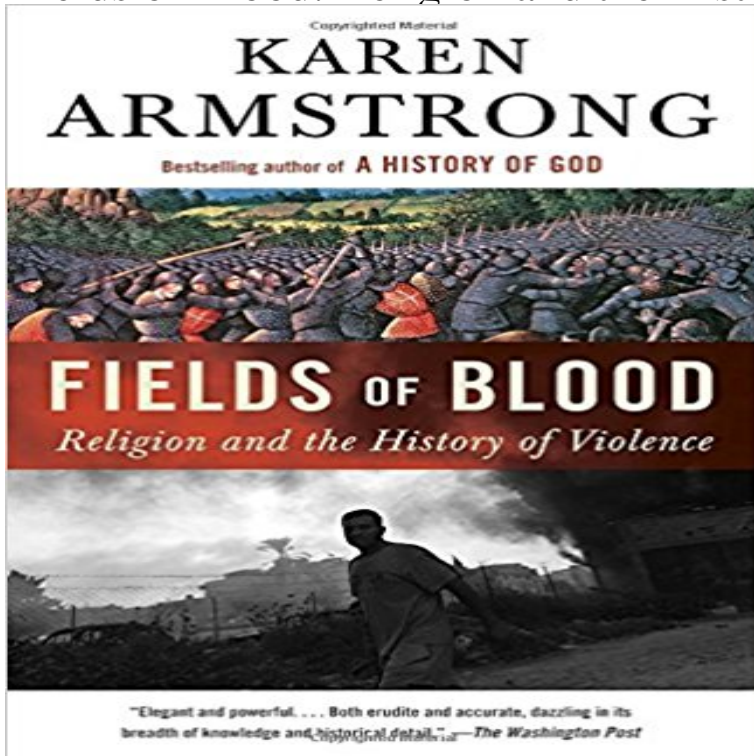


Fields of Blood: Religion and the History of Violence
