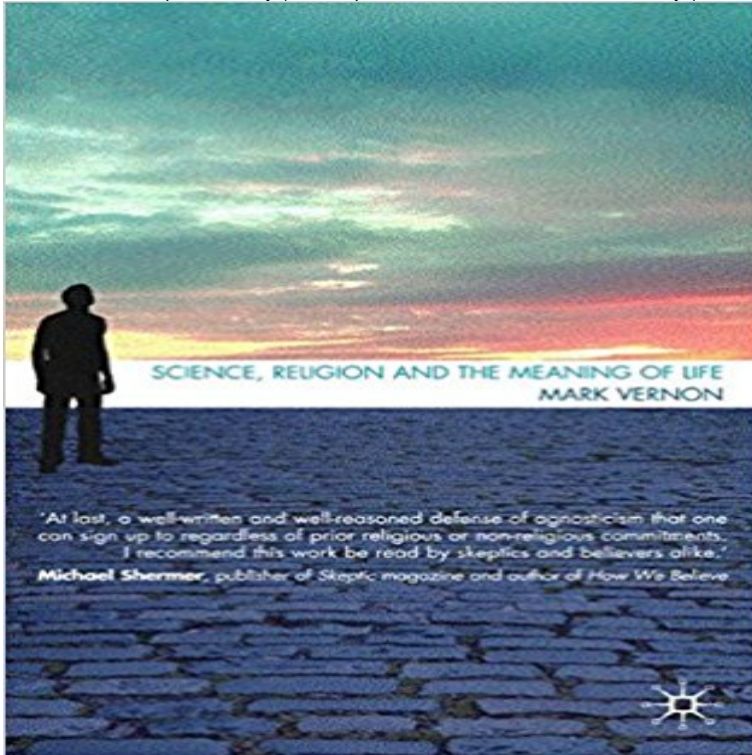


Science, Religion, and the Meaning of Life
