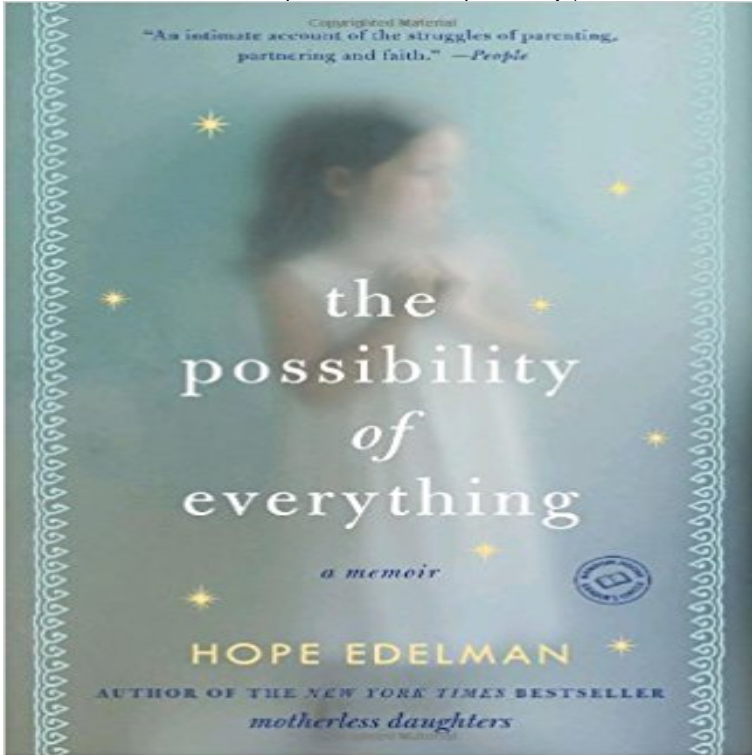


# The Possibility of Everything: A Memoir
