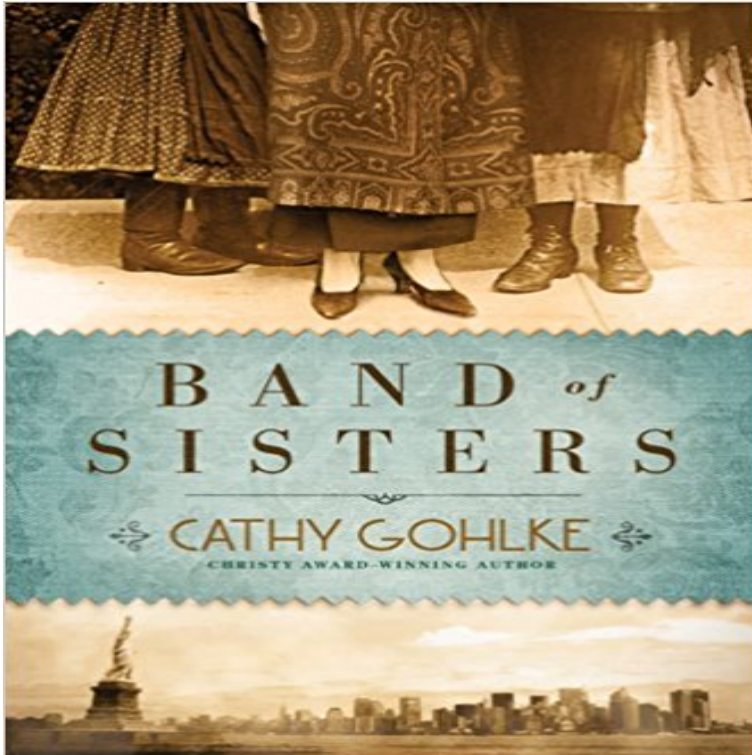


Band of Sisters
