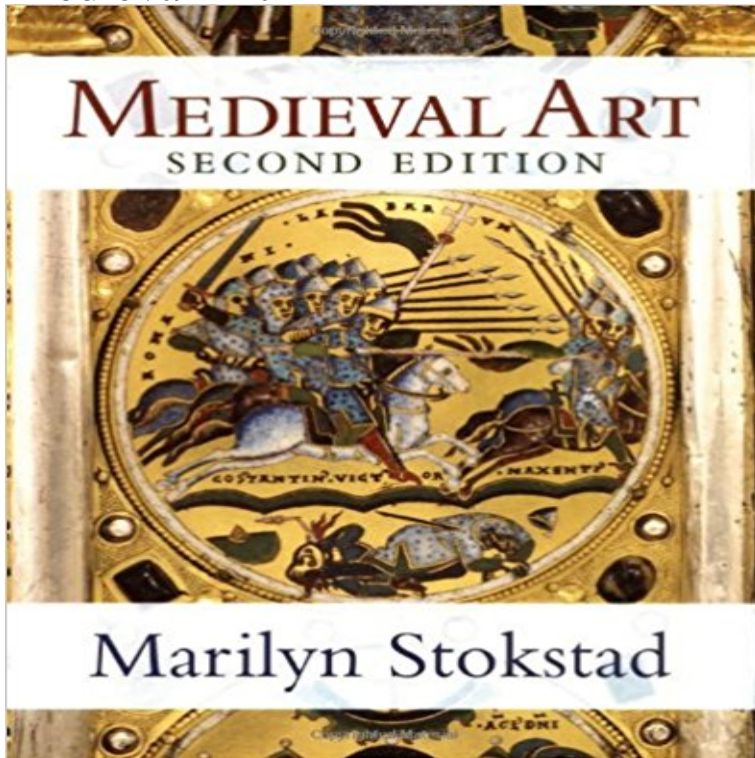


# Medieval Art
