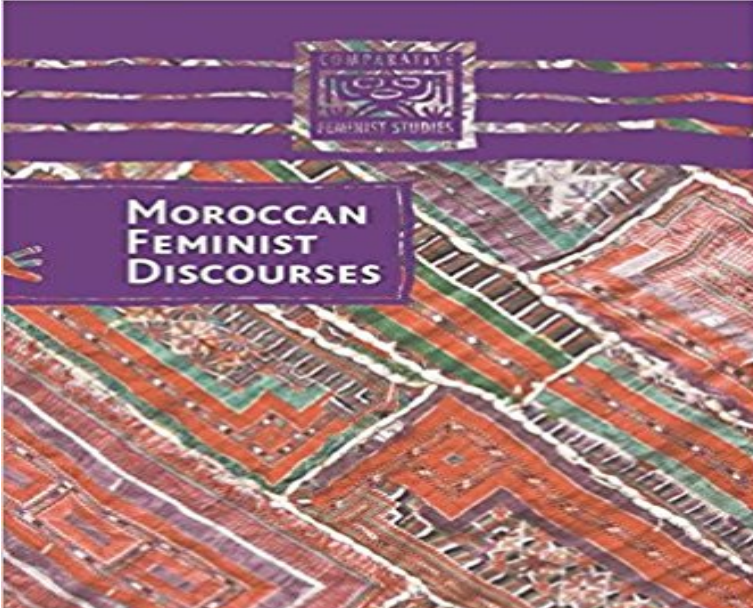


Moroccan Feminist Discourses (Comparative Feminist Studies)
