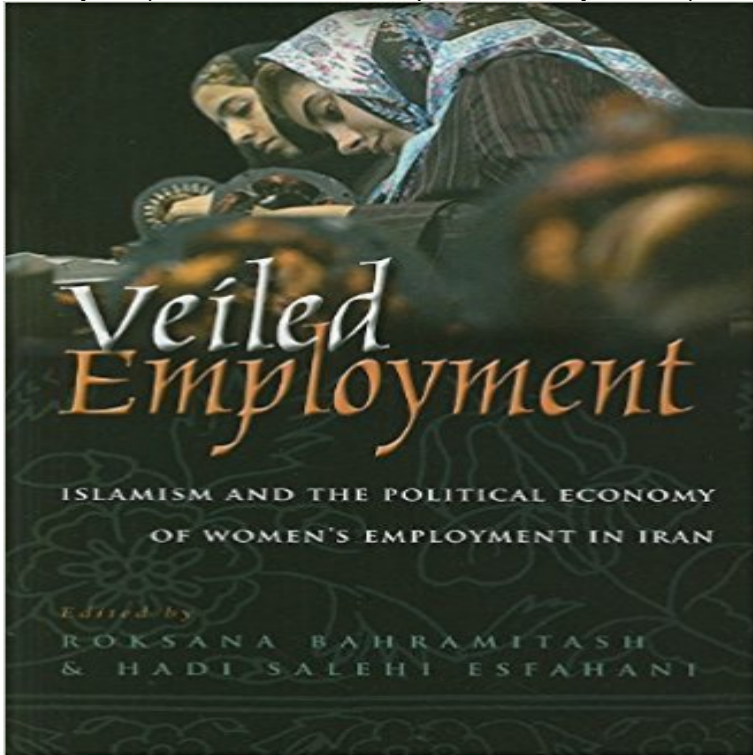


Veiled Employment: Islamism and the Political Economy of Womens Employment in Iran (Contemporary Issues in the Middle East)
