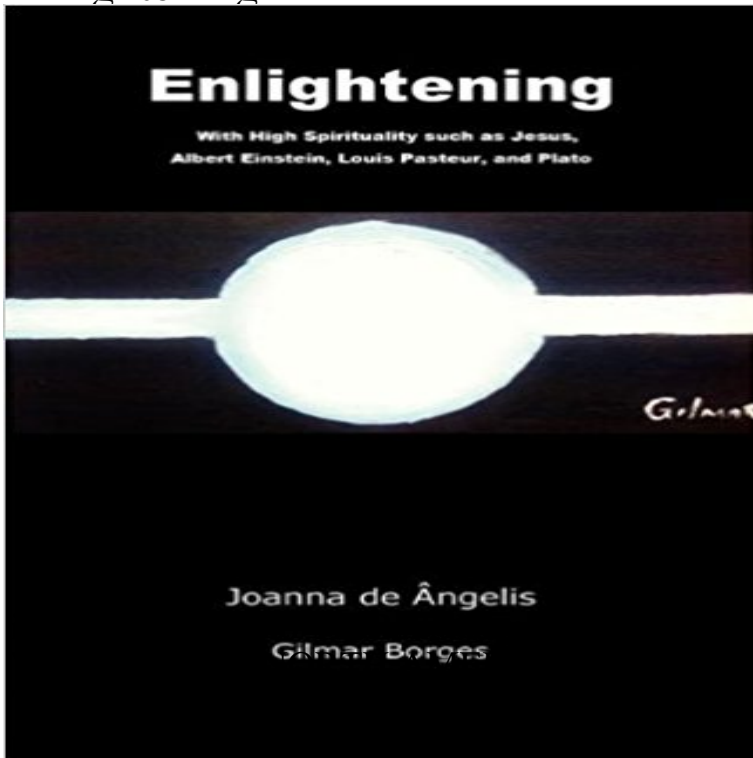


Enlightening
