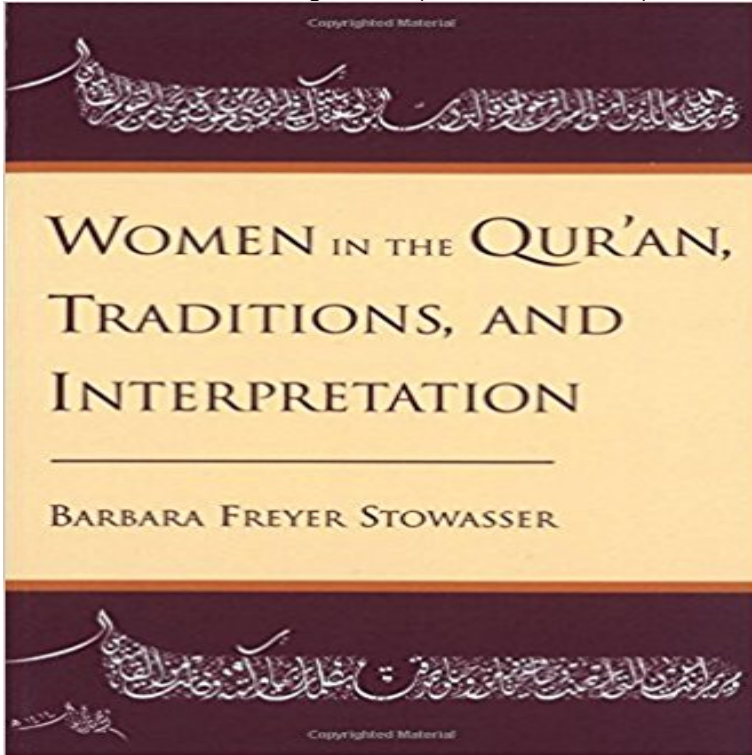


Women in the Quran, Traditions, and Interpretation

Despite the popular attention surrounding Middle Eastern attitudes toward women, there has been little systematic study of the statements regarding women in the Quran. Stowasser fills the void with this study on the women of Islamic sacred history. By telling their stories in Quran and interpretation, she introduces Islamic doctrine and its past and present socio-economic and political applications. Stowasser establishes the link between the female figure as cultural symbol, and Islamic self-perceptions from the beginning to the present time.
