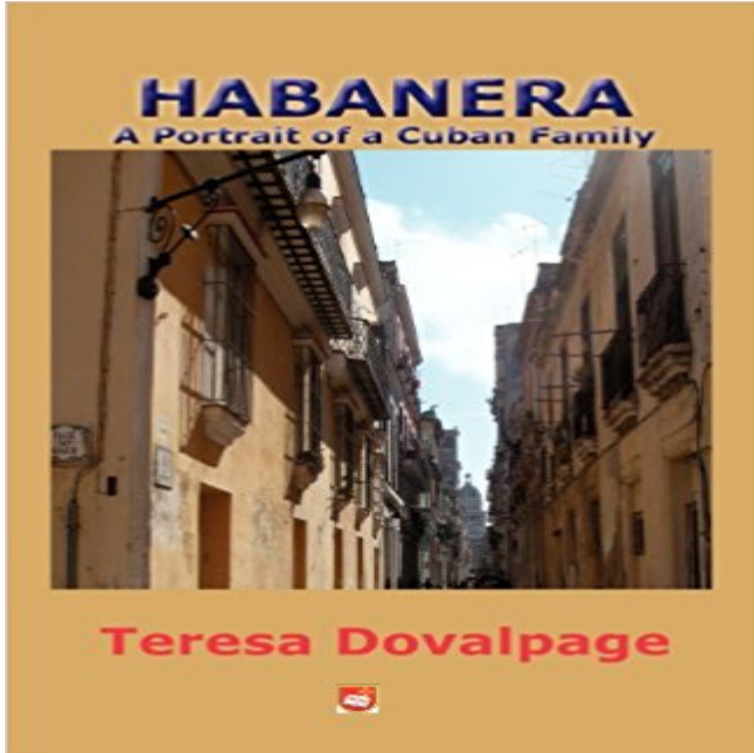


Habanera: A Portrait of a Cuban Family
