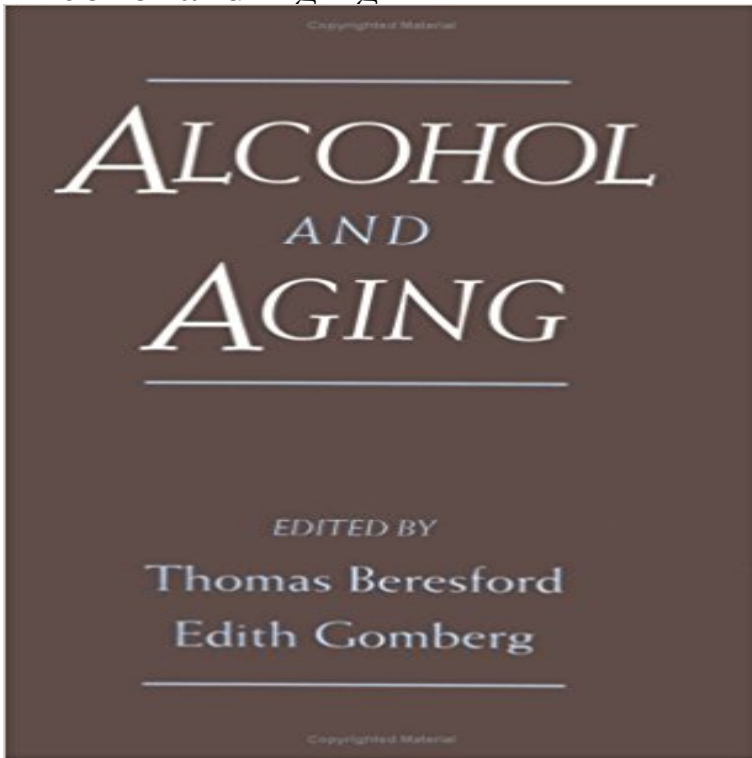


# Alcohol and Aging
