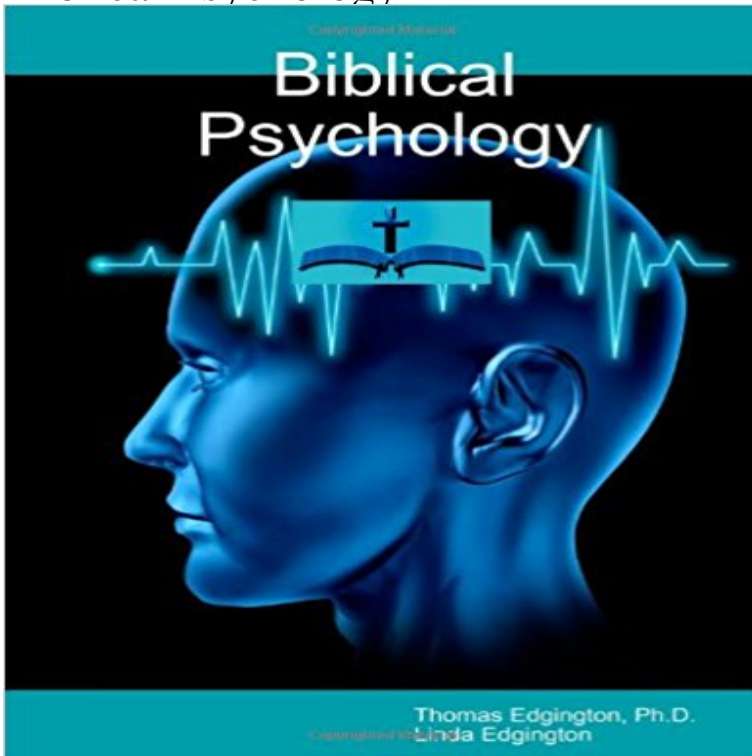


Biblical Psychology



Biblical Psychology is intended as a college textbook for Christian college students. Loaded with hundreds of Scripture references, it is an in-depth look at what the Bible says about thinking and behavior and how that relates to everyday lives. Written by a Christian psychologist and psychology professor who holds an M.Div. from Grace Theological Seminary and a Ph.D. in Counseling Psychology from Ball State University along with 30 years in the classroom and nearly 3 decades of counseling experience, the book weighs in on secular psychologists and secular psychological teachings and runs those teachings through a biblical grid. It is also filled with life examples that help the student relate to the specific areas being taught. Because it is Scripture-based, it can be a helpful tool for anyone who wants to explore what God intended for man to be and how the proper belief system is a key to godly behavior and healthy emotions. A teachers supplement with sample discussion and quiz questions is available.
