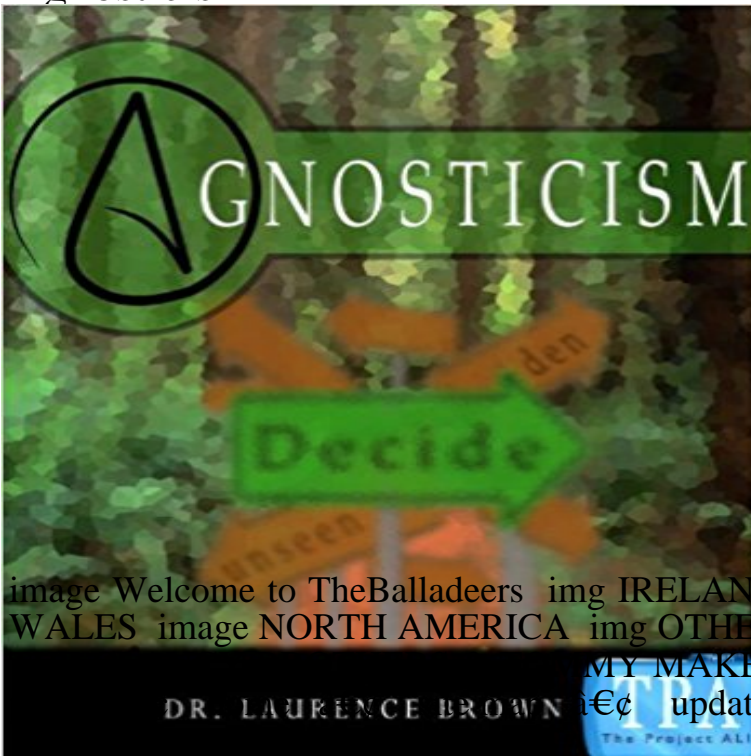


Agnosticism
