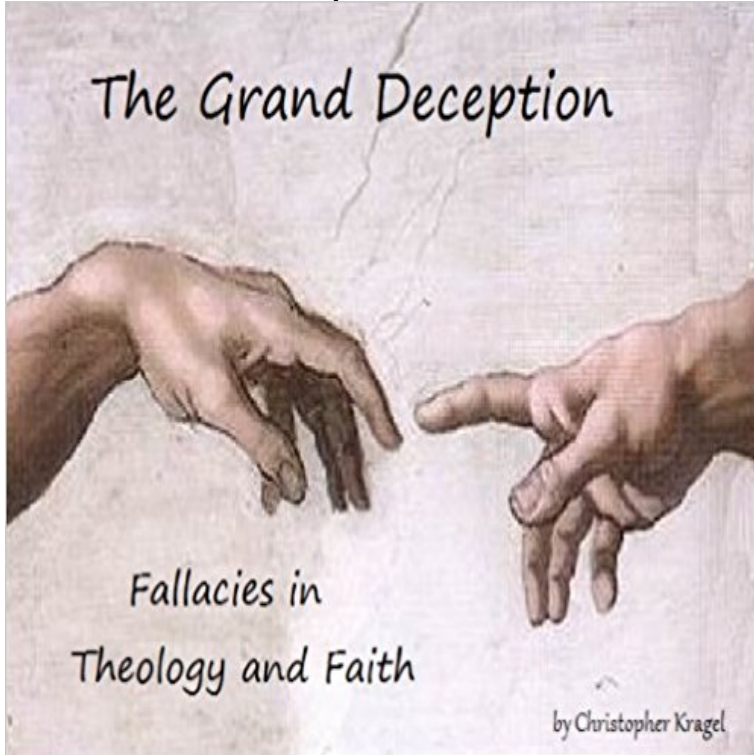


The Grand Deception : Fallacies in Theology and Faith
