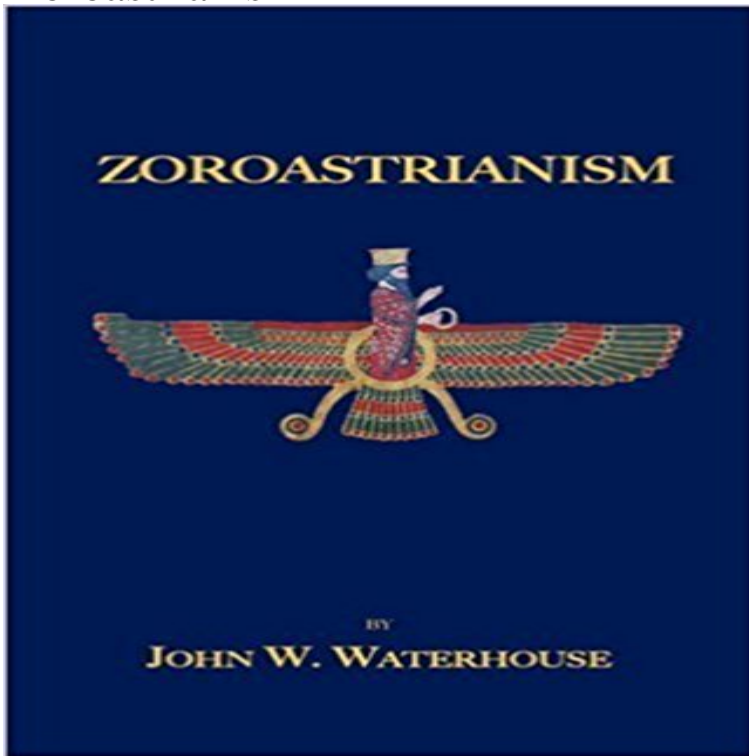


# Zoroastrianism
