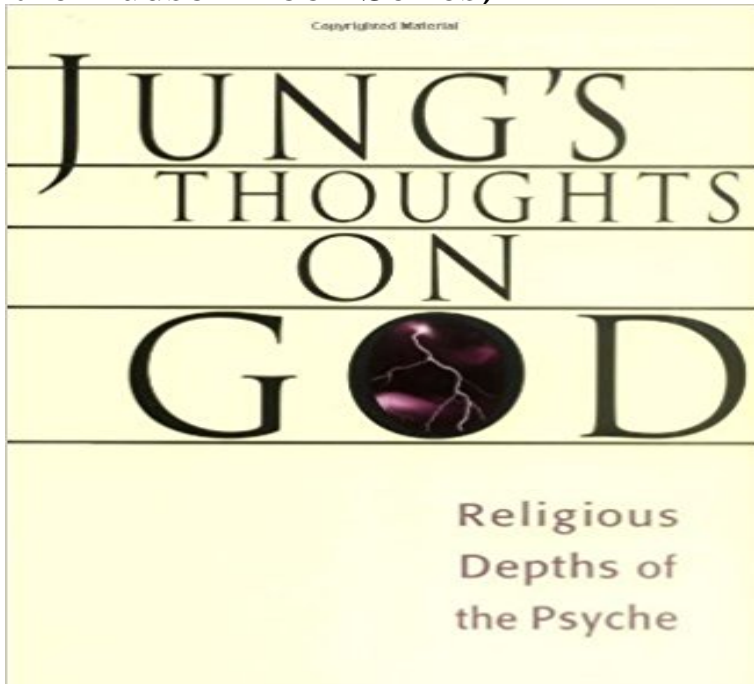


Jungs Thoughts on God: The Religious Depths of Our Psyches (Jung on the Hudson Book Series)
