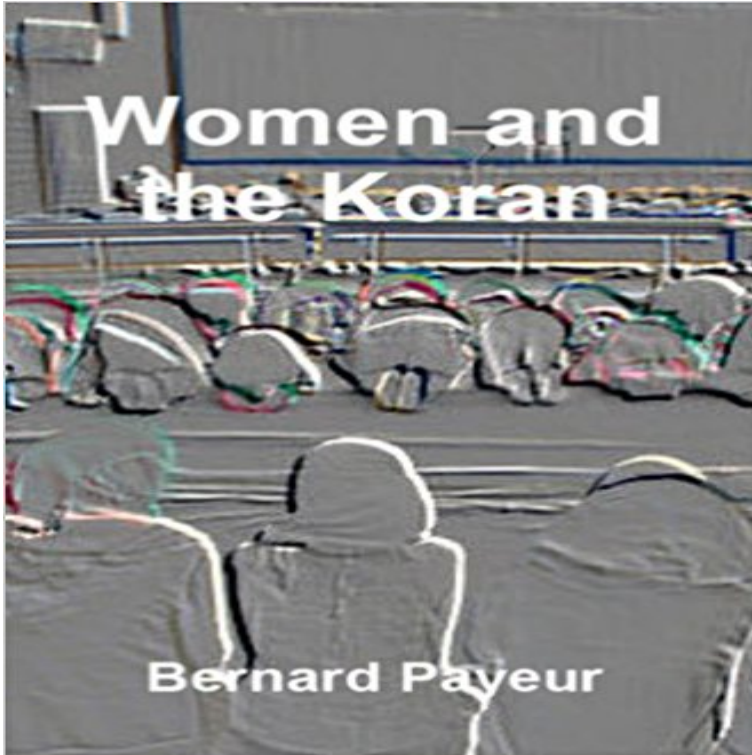


Women and the Koran
