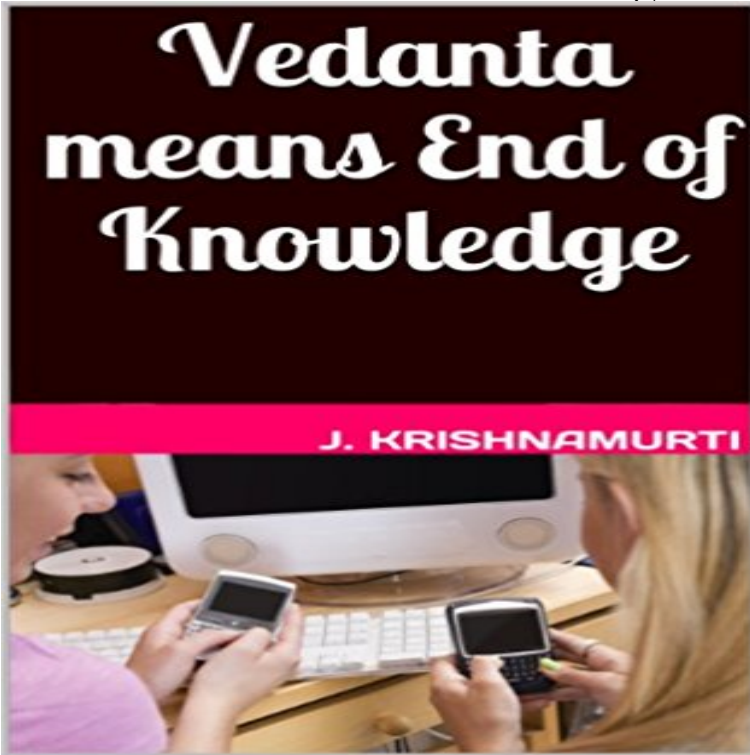


Vedanta means End of Knowledge
