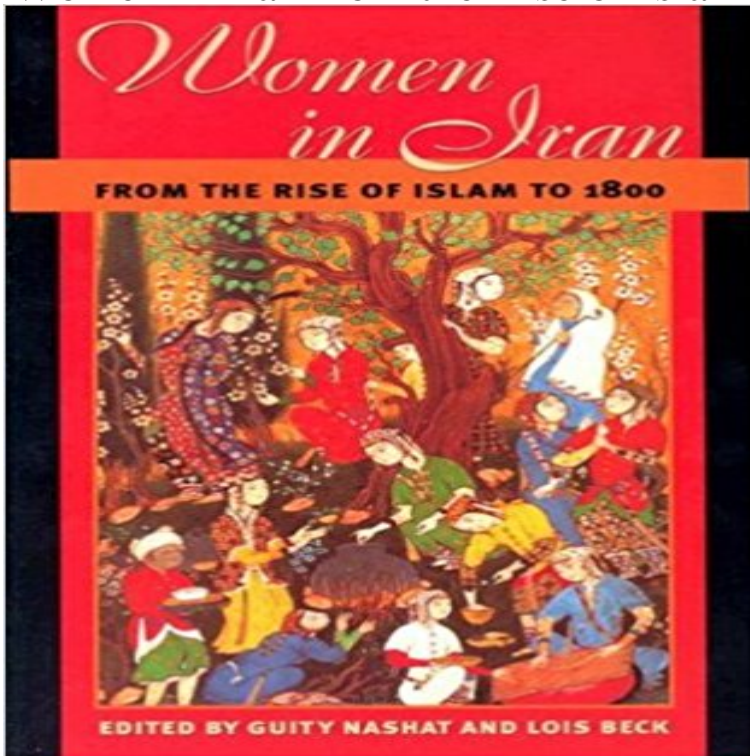


Women in Iran from the Rise of Islam to 1800
