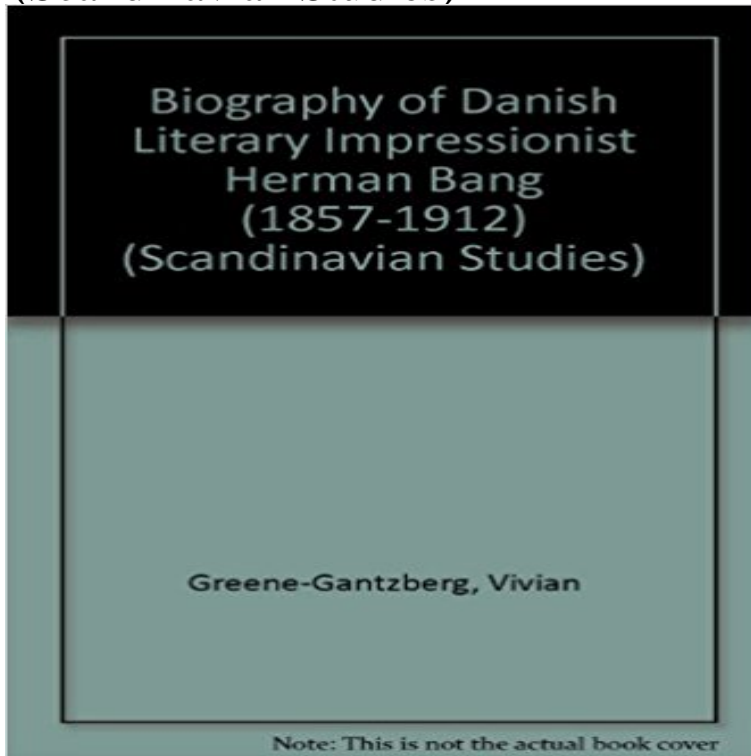


## Biography of Danish Literary Impressionist Herman Bang (1857-1912) (Scandinavian Studies)

This biography seeks to concentrate on how conditions depicted in Bangs works find resolution in his life.
