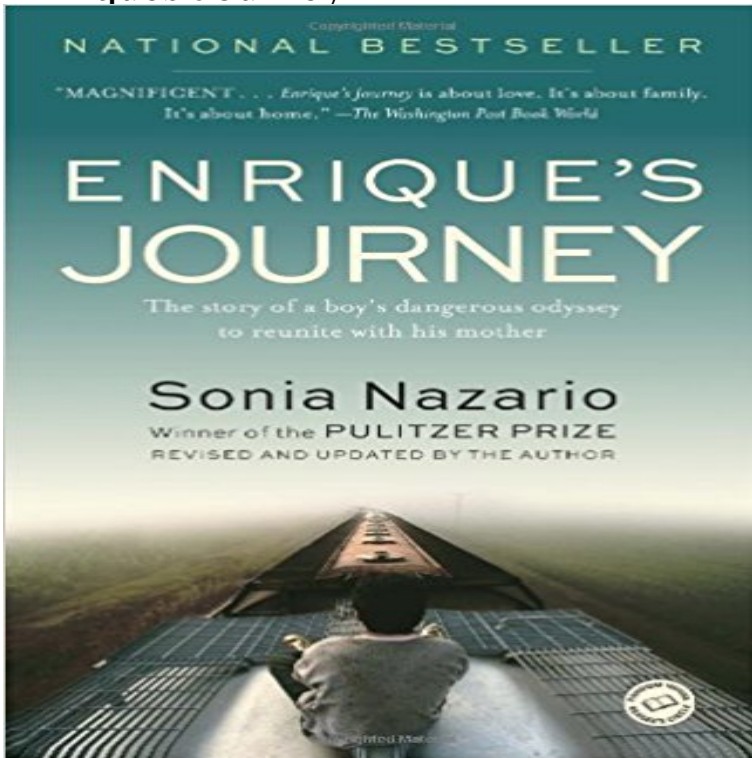


Enriques Journey
